01 Who We Are

Zambulance Health Services Ltd is a Zambian healthcare services company specialising in emergency medical services, ambulance transportation, patient transfers, event medical coverage, first aid training, roadside emergency assistance, paramedic services, and ambulance conversion and upgrade solutions.

Based in Ndola and Lusaka, Zambulance provides services across the country — serving individuals, hospitals, corporations, mining companies, financial institutions, NGOs, sporting organisations, event organisers, bush camps, and other institutions that require dependable medical support.

We operate a fleet of ten (10) ambulances, including 7 ALS-equipped ambulances. Our clinical personnel are registered with their respective councils and are deployed according to the clinical and operational needs of each assignment.

Inter-Hospital & Patient Transfers

Emergency and non-emergency transfers, hospital referrals, long-distance medical transfers, discharge transport and transport to scheduled appointments.

Neonatal, Paediatric & Adult Transfers

Patient transport across all age groups, including high-acuity and trauma transfers.

Specialised Medical Transport

Ongoing treatment and monitoring during transfer, with doctors, nurses, clinical officers, paramedics, anaesthetic personnel, and midwives deployed according to need.

Event Medical Coverage

Marathons, road races, sporting events, concerts, corporate functions, conferences, religious gatherings, festivals, schools, universities, and community events.

Sports & Marathon Support

Route medical coverage, mobile medical teams, first aid stations, patient assessment, stabilisation, evacuation, and medical coordination.

Roadside Assistance & Emergency Response

Road traffic accident response, emergency assessment, first aid, trauma support, stabilisation, evacuation, and hospital transfer.

05 First Aid, Home-Based Care & Dignified Transfers

First Aid & Emergency Response Training

Basic first aid, cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), basic life support (BLS), trauma and bleeding control, fractures, burns, choking, medical emergencies, road traffic accident response and emergency preparedness.

Home-Based Care & Patient Support

Patient transport, discharge transport, scheduled appointment transport, basic home-based medical support, and caregiver education.

Mortuary & Deceased Person Transfers

Hospital-to-mortuary, mortuary-to-mortuary, funeral home and authorised long-distance transfers, conducted with dignity, respect, and confidentiality.

Basic, intermediate, and full ambulance conversion; ambulance vehicle and equipment upgrades; patient compartment modification; stretcher and equipment mounting; oxygen and electrical upgrades; emergency lighting; storage and seating configuration; fleet management; equipment service plans; and statutory registration support.

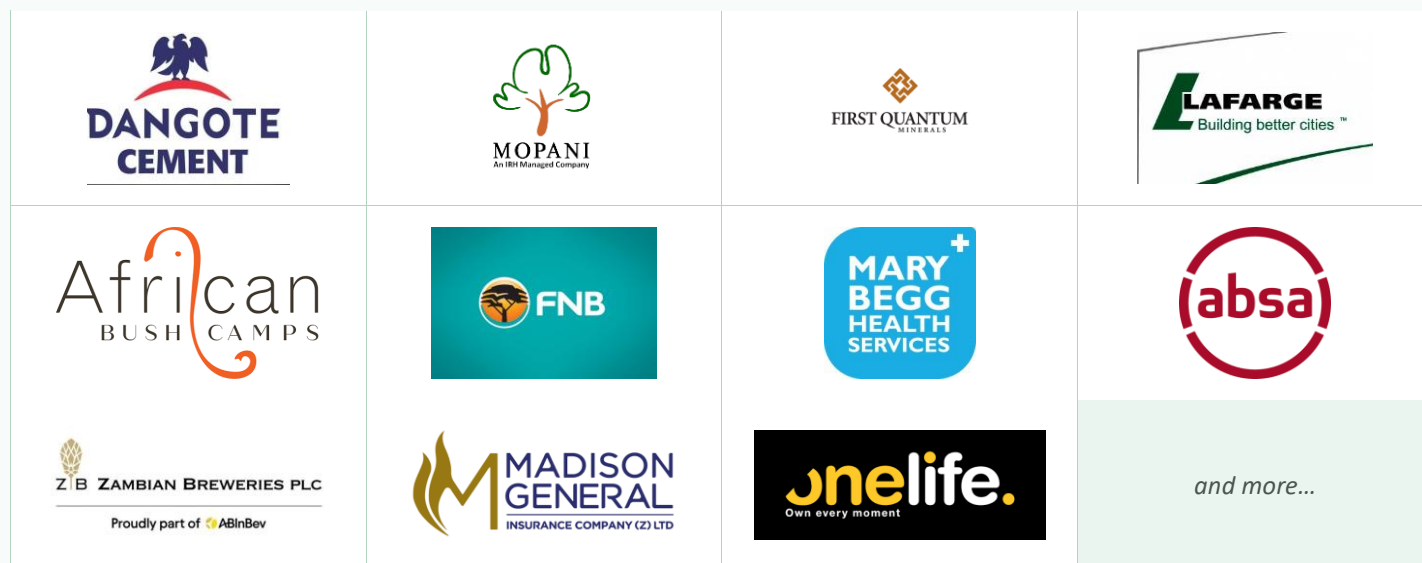

Selected Assignments and Service Highlights



Zambulance has supported major marathons involving more than 6,000 runners and spectators across 5 km, 10 km, 21 km and 42 km routes. The deployment incorporated route-based coverage, first aid support, ambulance response, communication and evacuation planning.

Event: FNB Marathon

Dates and location: 2024, 2025 and 2026 | Kitwe

Reported outcome: An average of 100 people assisted per year at these events, with an average response time of under 3 minutes.



Clinical teams and transport resources are selected according to patient acuity, distance and receiving-facility requirements. Services may include adult, paediatric, neonatal, specialist-supported and dignified transfers.

Selected assignment: Private transfer from a health centre to an aircraft for medical evacuation.

Transfer time: Pick-up to handover completed within 10 minutes.

Reported outcome: Patient handed over safely to the receiving medical team.



Zambulance provides practical first aid and emergency-response training for non-medical personnel, workplaces, institutions and community groups. Programmes can be adapted to occupational risks and participant needs.

Client or institution: Lolelunga Private Reserve

Courses and participants: Basic First Aid (9 participants); Advanced First Aid (2 participants).

Reported outcome: 10 of 11 participants successfully completed training and received certificates. One participant did not complete the training.

Client and service: Absa Marathon medical coverage

Location and years: Lusaka | 2024 and 2025

Reported outcome: No fatalities were recorded during the marathon. On-site teams provided care to casualties.

Client and service: Polocrosse medical coverage

Location and year: Lusaka | 2026

Reported outcome: Medical coverage was provided, and casualties received on-site care.

Patient safety, dignity, and professional service delivery are central to our operations.
